

The title of this abstract

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This template follows the guidelines for abstract submission to the [Manchester Phonology Meeting \(MfM\)](#):

- 1 page maximum
 - A4 paper
 - 2.5cm margins
 - single spacing
 - minimum 12pt font size
 - normal character spacing
 - optional full bibliography
 - IPA support

Examples can be provided like this:

- (1) Types of anchoring
 - a. Left-oriented
 - b. Right-oriented
 - c. Stress-dependent

Glosses can be provided like this:

- (2) Example of *h-aspiré* in standard French:

 - i. * Un hacker [ɛ.na.kœR] sait utiliser un ordinateur.
 - ii. Un hacker [ɛ.a.kœR] sait utiliser un ordinateur.
Un hacker sait utiliser un ordinateur.
A hacker can use a computer

Here is how to cite Chomsky (1965: 17) with parentheses around the year (and optionally the page, if provided as argument), (Chomsky 1965: 68) with parentheses around everything, or Chomsky 1965 without parentheses. An author entry {van Beethoven, Ludwig} in *references.bib* is alphabetically ranked in the bibliography as starting with a **B**, but the author entry {{van Beethoven}, Ludwig} is ranked as starting with a **V** (van Beethoven 1824).

An image without a caption can be added with the simple command *includegraphics*; an image with a caption can be added with the same command within a *figure* environment; and an image placed left or right from the main text (as in this example) can be generated by using the same configuration but with a *wrapfigure* environment (and specifying the alignment and width of the image).
